

Researcher in Accounting and / or Corporate Finance

The Faculty of Finance and Accounting (Prague University of Economics and Business) is seeking a candidate for the full-time “Researcher in Accounting and Corporate Finance” position (ranging from 0.75–1.00 FTE, depending on the mutual agreement). Candidates with a strong background in financial accounting, management accounting, sustainability reporting, auditing or corporate finance are expected to strengthen the Faculty’s research by publishing papers in peer-reviewed journals and processing their international research projects.

Job description:

- » elaborating own academic research in contemporary issues, preferably capital market research, sustainable reporting or artificial intelligence in accounting and corporate finance (other relevant topics in accounting and corporate finance are also possible)
- » regular publishing in internationally recognised accounting or finance journals
- » delivering seminars for PhD students

Expected qualifications:

- » PhD degree in accounting or a related discipline
- » enthusiasm and teaching skills, including the ability to work with and motivate students from different background

- » proved strong research track record in internationally recognised peer-reviewed journals (Web of Science: Q3 and better according to AIS; Scopus: Q1, Q2)
- » relevant international academic network
- » excellent communication skills and ability to work both independently and in a team

The application should include:

- » cover letter, including the motivation
- » curriculum vitae
- » list of publications (including the number of citations in the Web of Science)
- » a tentative research plan (papers, international projects etc.) to work on in the position applied for
